We take complaints and concerns from parents/carers seriously and will aim to resolve them as best we can. In order to do this, parents/carers need to follow our complaints procedure and raise any concerns by contacting the school directly, not via social media.

At Hebburn Comprehensive, we believe it is extremely important for our pupils to learn how to treat others with respect, including when they are online. Parents/carers have an important role to play in modelling this for their children. We ask parents/carers to kindly refrain from using inappropriate language, or from posting comments that are defamatory, rude, intimidating or threatening. Posting comments online does not help the school address the issue. It may also prevent the school from conducting a full and fair investigation or could present a serious safeguarding concern.

As a school we are always open to working with parents and carers to resolve issues in a supportive way. It is much better for children when school and parents/carers work together in partnership.
