BOOKING CONDITIONS

Additional Information:

The production begins at 2pm. Pupils will have their lunch in school and be taken to the theatre via coach. The running time of the production is 2 hours 30 with a 20 minute interval. Pupils will return to school at approximately 6.00pm.

Pupils can take light refreshments to the theatre along with money to purchase an ice-cream at the interval if this is made available. Pupils are not allowed to eat or drink on the coach.
