Additional Information:

Pupils will be taken to and from the theatre via coach. They must return to school for **6.15pm**. The coaches will leave school at **6.30pm** promptly and **will not wait** for late attenders.

The running time of the production is **1 hour 50 minutes**. This means pupils will return to school between **10.00pm and 10.15pm**, **On return, parents/carers are fully responsible for pupils and we ask pupils are collected by a nominated adult.**

Pupils can wear smart, casual clothing that **must be appropriate** for a visit to the theatre. This event is open to the public. Any poor behaviour could result in parents/carers being asked to collect their child immediately from the venue.

Pupils are not allowed to eat or drink on the coach. Light refreshments can be taken to the theatre but they must be sealed as they enter the building. **The theatre is cashless venue and there will be limited possibilities to buy refreshments on the night.**
