FLAMINGOLAND 2025

Wednesday 9th July

PURPOSE

At the end of the current academic year, we propose to take pupils to Flamingoland on Wednesday 9th July.

The cost of the visit this year will be £45.00. This includes transport to and from Flamingoland and entry into the park. We anticipate leaving school at 8.00am promptly and leaving the park at 3.30pm. This means returning to school at approximately 6.00pm

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Please note, this trip is booked many months in advance to secure the number of buses needed. This means that there is an **initial limit on the number of pupils who can attend**, **but every effort will be made to take all eligible pupils**. In addition, if a payment deadline is missed, there will be a 'waiting list' system in place; however, there is no guarantee that pupils will be able to attend.

Additional Information

Pupils need to make provision for their own lunch by either taking a packed lunch or purchasing food at one of the numerous outlets across the park. **Pupils eligible for free school meals who want a packed lunch, can order one directly from Mrs Moore.**

Any pupil who takes valuable items is doing that at their own risk. The school cannot accept liability in the event of loss or damage.

Pupils will be allowed to go around the park **in groups and must never be alone**. Staff will be strategically positioned within the park at specified points throughout the day to help, if needed. Pupils will be provided with maps.

As the journey to Flamingo Land takes **about two hours**, any pupil who suffers from travel sickness should take the appropriate medication at the correct times. Pupils also need to dress appropriately for the weather and bring sun protection, if necessary. All coaches are fitted with seat belts; please ensure that your child knows that it is imperative to wear these throughout the journey.
